- 3 Attention is drawn to the requirements in Section 3 of the Code, referring to Peel Ports Medway's policy on the bunkering of Liquefied Natural Gas powered ships. The policy is –

'At the present time LNG bunkering is not routinely permitted within the Peel Ports Medway area of jurisdiction. Any vessel wishing to carry out LNG bunkering operations are required to contact the Marine Management Team with their planned procedures and specific risk assessments prior to arranging for LNG bunkers to be delivered'.
