## Compulsory Pilotage

Pilotage is compulsory for certain vessels; details are in the [Pilotage Directions](#).

## Booking a Pilot

Advance booking is required and requests must be received adequately in advance of the proposed Vessel arrival/movement/departure time. See Contact details below.

It is recommended arriving Vessels submit a booking for pilotage 24 hours in advance and not less than ETA-8 hours. Thereafter, there is a requirement for confirmation at ETA-2 hours (for departing Vessels ETD-2hours).

## Pilotage Charges

The cost of Pilotage varies dependent on Size of Vessel and other factors. See [Port Charges](#).

## Hours of Service

The Port is able to receive Pilotage Requests on a 24/7 basis and endeavours to meet all requirements, subject to Pilot availability.

VHF Channel 12 is monitored 24 hours by the Local Port Service Officer (Call Sign: Yarmouth Radio) and at the Pilot Station (Call Sign: Yarmouth Pilots).
