WASTE RECEPTION FACILITIES AT QUEEN ELIZABETH II DOCK

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that following recent incidents of waste skip contamination and dumping of hazardous waste articles on the quayside, the following requirements must be observed by all vessels berthing at the Queen Elizabeth II Dock (“the Dock”) and making use of the waste reception facilities.

Non-Hazardous Non-Recyclable Domestic Waste (Red-Lid Skip)

Non-hazardous non-recyclable domestic waste, such as food waste (including international catering waste), packaging contaminated with food, glass jars and bottles must be placed into the waste skips with red lids.



Non-Hazardous Dry Mixed Recyclable Waste (Orange-Lid Skip)

Non-hazardous dry mixed recyclable waste, such as empty plastic bottles, tins and cans, paper and cardboard must be placed into the waste skips with orange lids. Items placed into these waste skips must be loose, not bagged.



Two pairs of waste skips are available at the Dock. One pair of waste skips is located at the northern end of Berth №3, whilst the second pair of waste skips is located at the western end of Berth №2.

Disposal of waste other than that acceptable for disposal in either the red- or orange-lid waste skips must be arranged via the appointed ship agent. Waste of this nature must be discharged directly from the vessel to the waste carrier's vehicle.

Masters of vessels who permit their crews to contaminate the waste skips with incompatible waste or to deposit waste of any type on the quayside will be committing an offence, which may render the Master liable, on conviction, to a fine. MSCC will also raise charges to the master and owners of an offending vessel for the recovery of all costs incurred for the removal of waste landed improperly and the decontamination of waste skips.
