

Mariners are advised that barge BHV Innovation with project cargo is expected at Cumbrae Heads around 0600 on Saturday 7th March for transit to BAE Govan. The barge is not powered and will be supported by the sea tug Fairplay-62.

On arrival at Tail of the Bank/Whiteforeland Buoy area, the sea tug will disconnect and harbour tugs Svitzer Milford, Svitzer Anglegarth and CMS Wrestler will assist the barge to BAE Govan. The sea tug Fairplay-62 will follow.

Between 1000 and 1400 on Saturday 7th March, movements in the River Clyde Channel will be restricted whilst the barge makes its transit to BAE Govan. Mariners are requested to avoid navigating the River during this time and remain well clear of all vessels involved.

A listening watch will be maintained by all vessels on VHF Ch12 throughout.
