

## NOTICE TO MARINERS

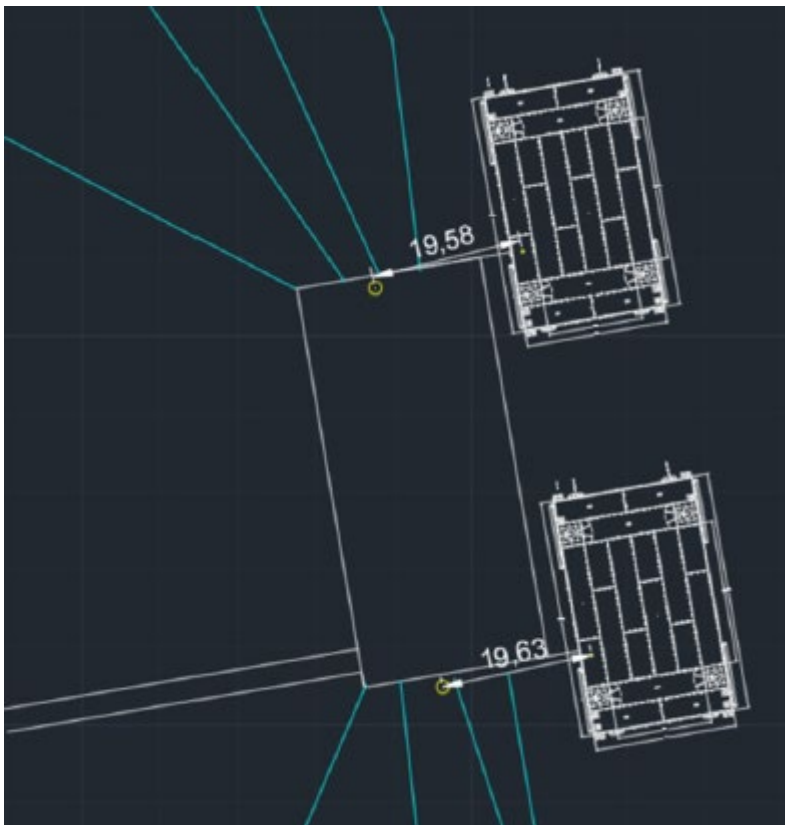

### PORT OF LIVERPOOL

#### BOREHOLE DRILLING OFF WOODSIDE LANDING STAGE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, on or shortly after 12 March 2024, the jack up barge *OCM 400* (30.5m × 18.5m) will be positioned c. 4.5m off the berth face of the Woodside Landing Stage to undertake borehole drilling operations.

Initially, the *OCM 400* will work at the northern end of the landing stage before shifting to a position at the southern end of the landing stage, as shown below.



During the daily working periods (06.00 to 20.00), the support vessel *Wave Dancer* will be in attendance and communications can be established with the *Wave Dancer* on VHF Ch. 12. Outside the daily working periods, the *OCM 400* will be unmanned.

During the time that the *OCM 400* is on station at Woodside Landing Stage, only those vessels involved with the borehole project and Liverpool Pilot Launches will be permitted to berth at the Landing Stage.

Whilst the *OCM 400* is on station, vessels passing Woodside Landing Stage must do so at a suitable distance and speed to minimize the effects of wash on the jack up barge and its support craft.

The borehole drilling operation should be completed within seven days of the *OCM 400* arriving on station. A further Notice will be issued when the operation has been completed.
