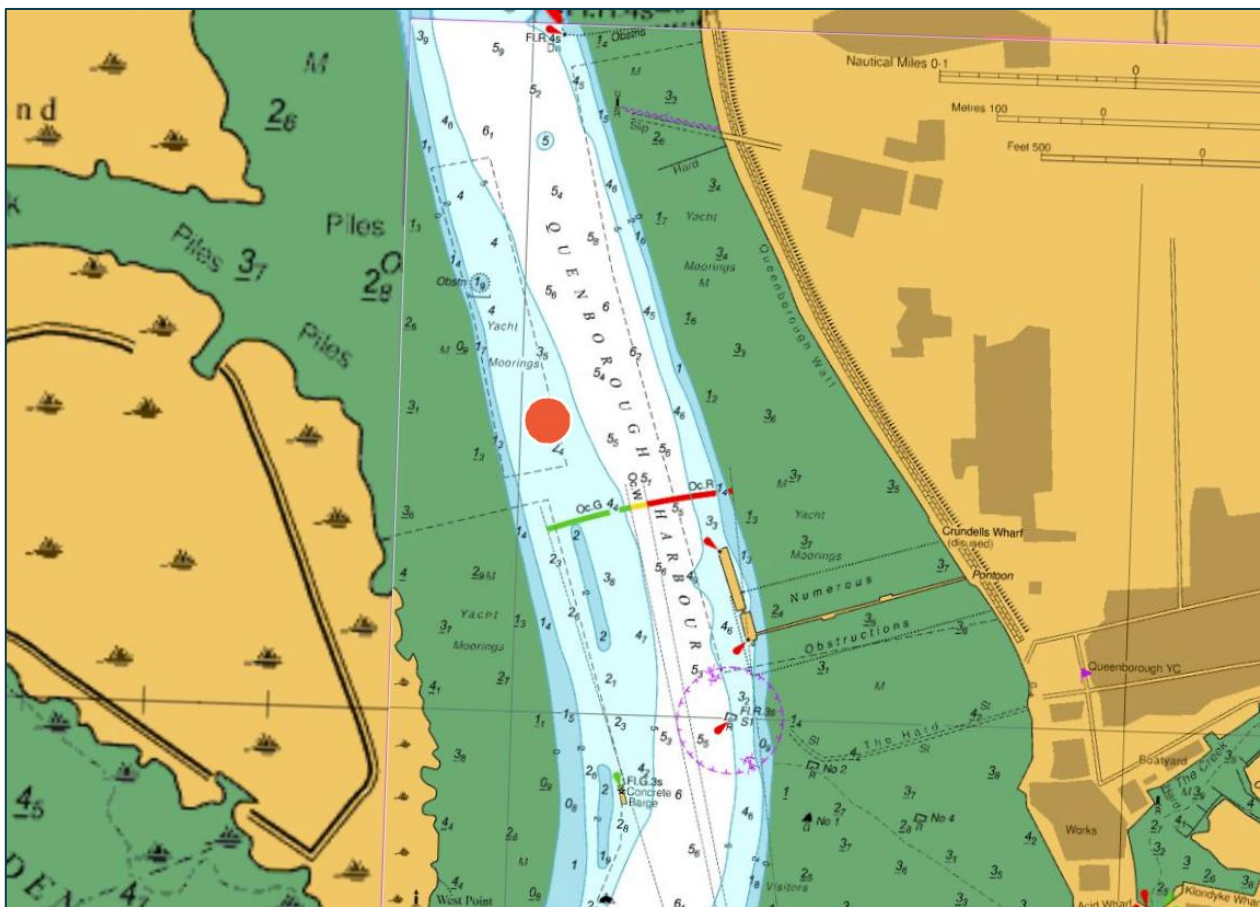

### Sunken Yacht – Hazard to Navigation

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the sunken vessel has now been recovered.**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:** Peel Ports have been notified of a sunken yacht which is creating a hazard to leisure craft in Queenborough Harbour. The yacht which lies in the following approximate position is still partially visible but is currently unmarked (see below). The owner has been contacted and efforts to recover the boat will commence as soon as possible. A cancellation to this notice will be published when the yacht has been lifted and recovered.
