



## **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

### **COMMON EUROPEAN REPORTING SYSTEM ("CERS") VERSION 3**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that with effect from 1st April 2017, in accordance with the requirements of Version 3 of CERS, vessels' Masters and agents must report details of vessel arrivals, dangerous and polluting goods (hazmat), waste and residues, and security information using the newly developed CERS Workbook.

UK port authorities have been mandated to collate the CERS Workbooks for vessels calling to their ports and send this information to CERS. Details of the Port's requirements to comply with this obligation (including a copy of the CERS Workbook, a guide to the new CERS3 reporting process and Q&A information sheet) can be found on the Peel Ports Group's website at <https://www.peelports.com/marine-information>.
