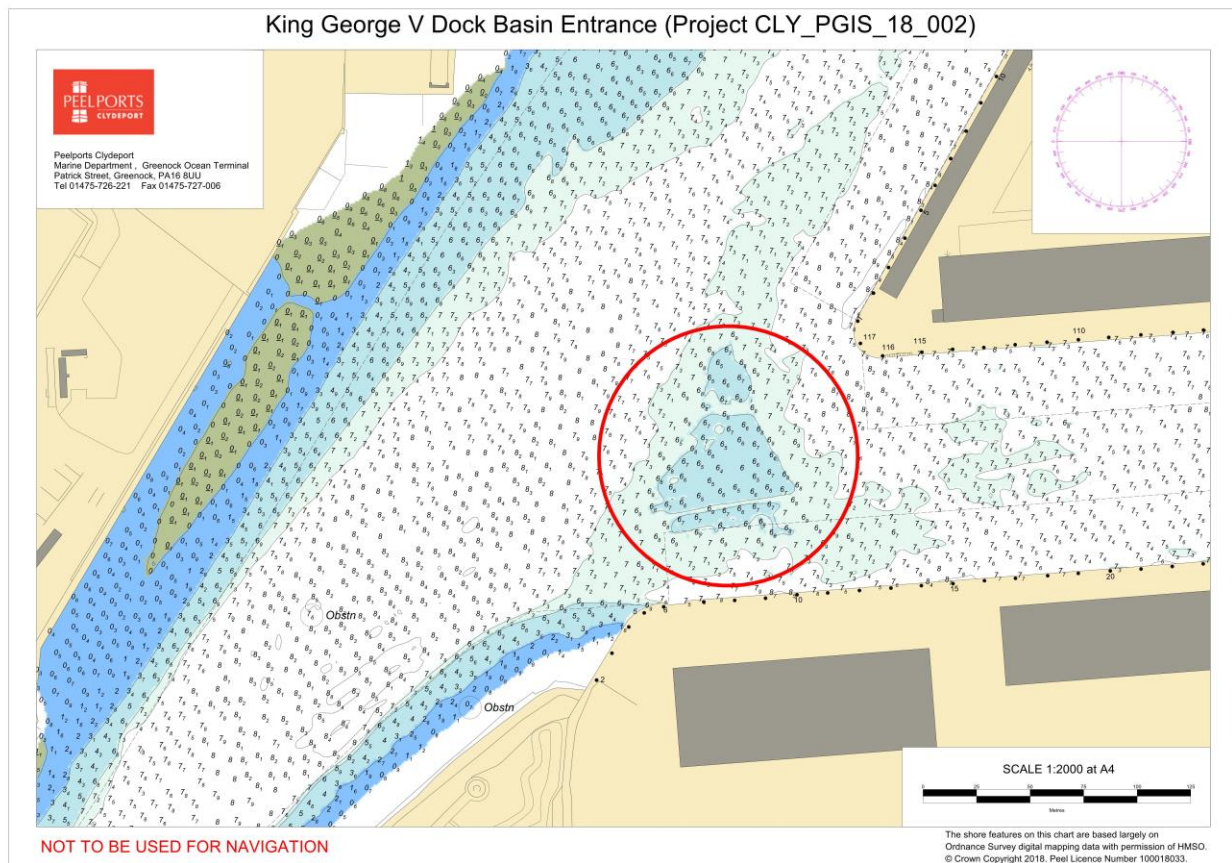

DREDGING WORKS

Chart 2007, Plan C

Mariners are advised that a further period of plough dredging works will be carried out in the area of the entrance to King George V Dock, Glasgow, as indicated on the chart extract below:



The works will be conducted by COASTWORKER from Monday 12th February for a period of approximately 5 days. The vessel may be restricted in her ability to manoeuvre during dredging works and mariners are requested to operate with caution in this area and allow a wide berth.

All vessels approaching or sailing from KGV Dock are requested to contact COASTWORKER at least 30 minutes in advance in order that dredging works may be suspended to allow access.
