GREENOCK OCEAN TERMINAL – BOREHOLE SAMPLING WORKS

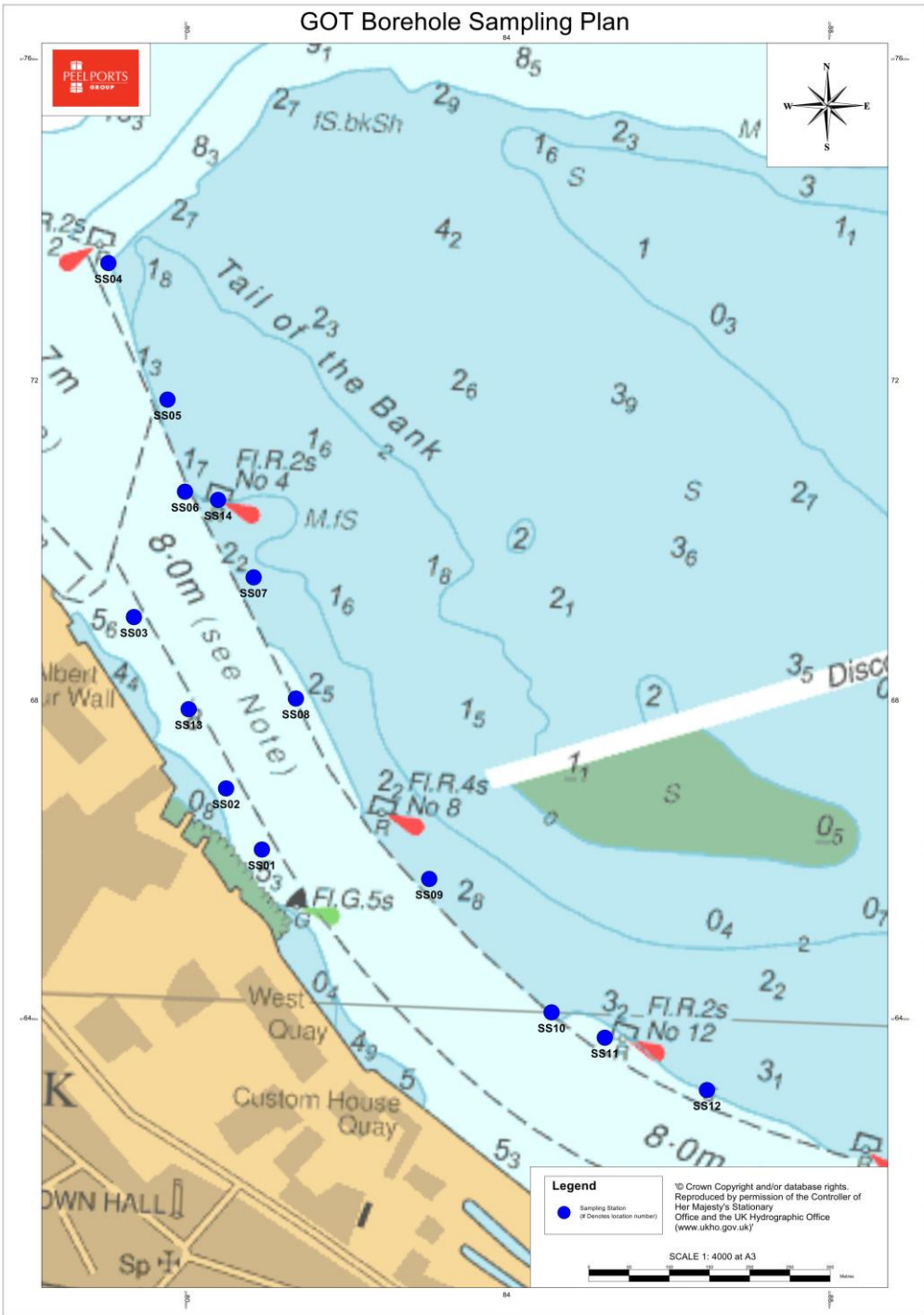
Mariners are advised that borehole sampling works will be carried out to the area adjacent to Greenock Ocean Terminal as illustrated in the chart extract below. The works will be conducted by CHALLENGER OF LEITH and associated spud leg pontoon which will have limited ability to manoeuvre. These works will start on or around Tuesday 5th June for a period of approximately 10 days. Drilling operations will take place between the hours of 0800 and 1700, and appropriate lights and shapes will be displayed by the vessel during operational periods, with a listening watch maintained on VHF 12 and 16.

ANY VESSEL TRANSITING THIS AREA DURING THE PERIOD OF THE WORKS IS ADVISED TO CONSULT ESTUARY RADIO IN ADVANCE OF THEIR PASSAGE TO CONFIRM THE CURRENT LOCATION OF THE JACKUP RIG.
