### **RIVER CLYDE – BAE GOVAN DREDGING OPERATIONS**

Mariners are advised that dredging works are scheduled to begin on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June in the vicinity of BAE Govan and will continue for a period of approximately six week. The vessels carrying out the works will be the MV Shearwater and barge CW4.

**HOPPER DREDGER M.V. SHEARWATER**



The works will be carried out between the hours of 0630-2130 and may occasionally operate outwith these hours. It is anticipated that the MV Shearwater will transit downriver to the spoil ground at Cloch Point approximately one to two times in every 24 hour period. For overnight berthing either Govan or Rothesay Dock (Clyde Boatyard) will be used.
