

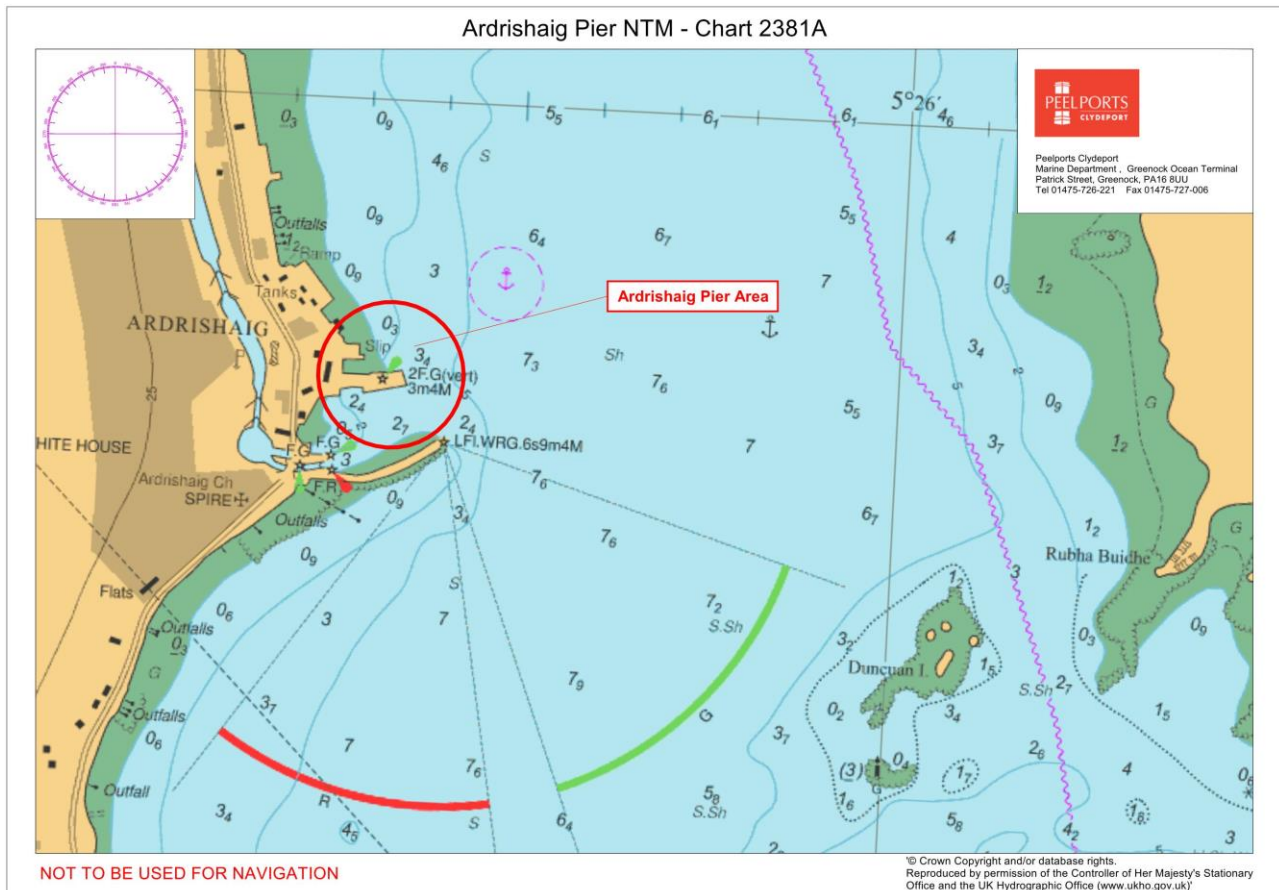

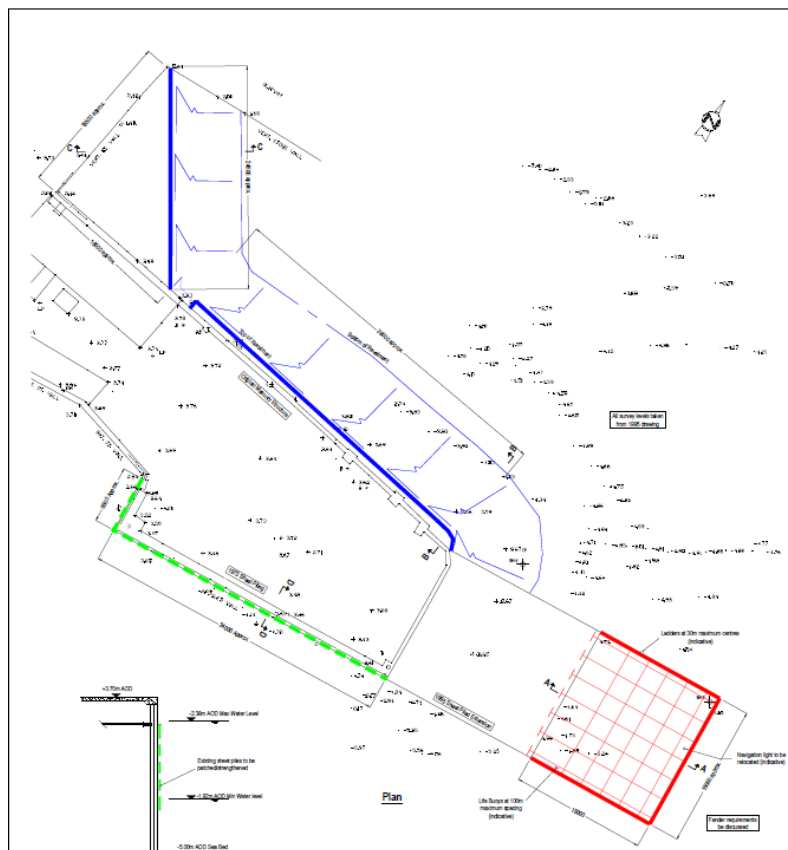
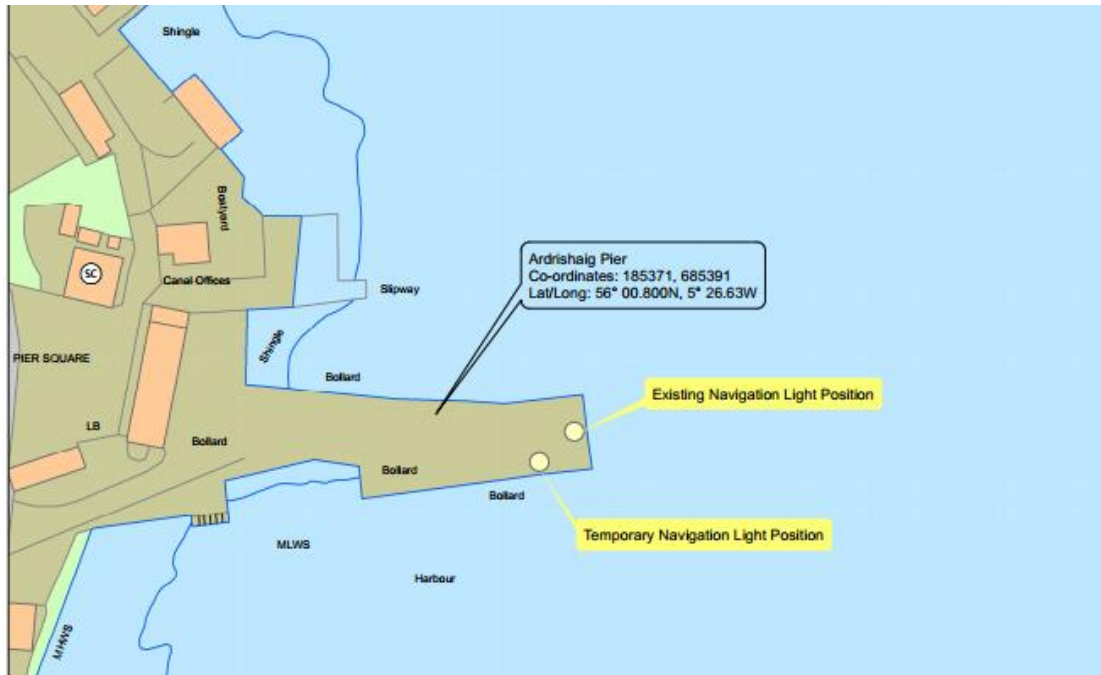
**FIRTH OF CLYDE – ARDRISHAIG PIER MAINTENANCE WORKS**

**Chart 2381 Plan A**

Mariners are advised that works to carry out essential structural upgrades and improvements at Ardrishaig Pier continue. Repairs are required to be carried out on a section of the existing sheet pile structure and this work will be completed by divers. Therefore the Pier will remain closed for all navigation and freight activity for a further period of approximately 10 weeks (completing on or around w/c 8<sup>th</sup> October 2018). When dive works are under way the appropriate lights and shapes will be displayed by the support craft.



During the construction period the navigation light on the pier has been relocated approx. 20m to a temporary position as illustrated in the first plan below. This light will be moved to its new permanent position by the end of August 2018 (illustrated on the second plan below).



Mariners are asked to navigate with caution in this area and consider the effects of wash. Estuary Radio may be contacted on VHF 12 or on ☎ 0151 949 6651.
