



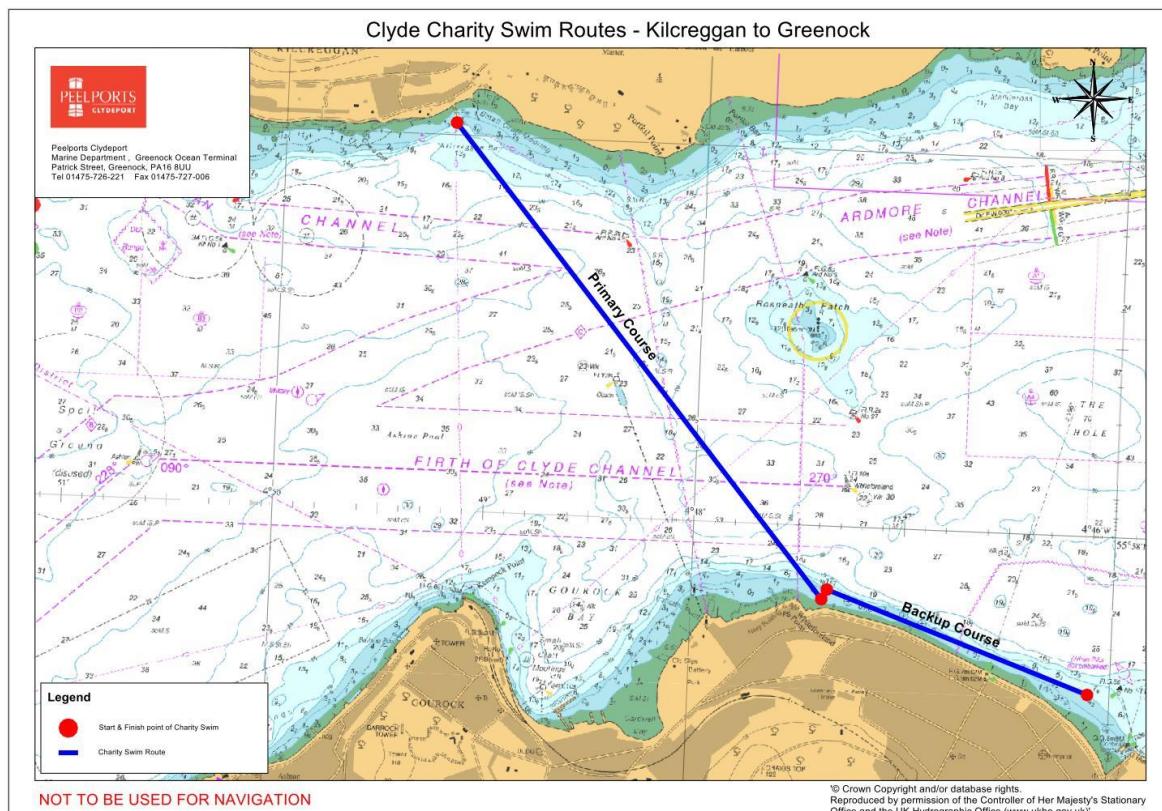
NOTICE TO MARINERS

FIRTH OF CLYDE – ROYAL WEST OF SCOTLAND AMATEUR BOAT CLUB CLYDE SWIM

Mariners are advised that the Royal West of Scotland Amateur Boat Club (RWSABC) are organising a Clyde Swim between Kilcreggan Pier and the RWSABC Club house at the West end of the Esplanade, in Greenock, on Saturday 4th August 2018. Should weather or commercial traffic density exceed expectations, an alternative course up and down the shore front of the Greenock Esplanade will be used. See Chartlet below.



Safety boats and Kayaks will be providing cover. Swimmers are expected to start the swim at Kilcreggan Pier at 1700 and it is expected that the last swimmer will be at the RWSABC about 1845. The maximum number of swimmers will be 32 and there will be a minimum of 10 Kayaks and 4 powered safety boats during the event. All swimmers will be wearing bright coloured Swim Caps with individual numbers for ease of identification. Event safety boats and the lead Kayak will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch 12 and 16.
