PORT OF GREAT YARMOUTH

Movements of vessels over 40m LOA within the Port of Great Yarmouth limits

Following from an incident that occurred on 30th September 2018, Mariners are advised that until further notice no vessel over 40m LOA is permitted to move within Great Yarmouth port limits without an authorised Pilot or PEC on board and Peel Ports Great Yarmouth Marine Crew handling the mooring lines.

Pilots and Marine Crew can be ordered with a minimum of 2 hours notice via LPS on VHF channel 12 call sign "Yarmouth Radio". This increase in Pilots and Mooring Crew use stresses the importance of giving plenty of notice of intended movements beyond the required 2 hours notice.

As an additional measure movements will be restricted to one per time slot to enable GY LPS to prioritise workload and vessel movements. Vessel movements will be scheduled in order of receipt of a request to move and the availability of personnel.
