TEMPORARY REMOVAL OF AIDS TO NAVIGATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate dredging in the Queens and Crosby Channels, the following aids to navigation will be removed from station on or shortly after 8 January 2024:

Formby Safe Water Mark

Crosby Safe Water Mark

Whilst Formby SWM and Crosby SWM are off station, the following reference points should be taken in lieu in respect of the application of General Direction №15:

Formby SWM: A line drawn between Q4 and Q5

Crosby SWM: A line drawn between C12 and C15

Furthermore, whilst Crosby SWM is off station, the position of this reporting point for the application of General Direction №16(ii) should be taken as:

C15 Buoy (inward) and C12 Buoy (outward)

The aids to navigation are expected to remain off station for approximately three weeks to enable dredging by the *Vox Apolonia* and subsequent bed levelling.

A further Notice will be issued when these aids to navigation are due to be reinstated.
