MARINE CASUALTY AND MARINE INCIDENT REPORTING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Mariners' attention is drawn to the recent amendment to MGN 564(M+F) regarding marine casualty and marine incident reporting in accordance with The Merchant Shipping (Accident Reporting and Investigation) Regulations 2012 (as amended).

In addition to the obligations placed upon Masters, senior surviving officers and owners of vessels involved in any marine casualty or marine incident, the aforementioned Regulations also require Harbour Authorities to notify the Marine Accident Investigation Branch (MAIB) of any marine casualty or marine incident occurring within their area of jurisdiction.

Therefore, to enable MDHC to fulfil its reporting obligations, any person who makes a report to the MAIB regarding any marine casualty or marine incident occurring within the limits of the Port of Liverpool must also provide details to MDHC via merseymarinemanagers@peelports.com. For the avoidance of doubt, this report will be in addition to any contemporaneous notification to Mersey VTS or the relevant Dock Master and any other report required in accordance with MDHC's various Directions, Guidelines or Byelaws.
