REPAIRS TO GLADSTONE LOCK EAST WALL

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that as part of repair works taking place at Gladstone Lock, it will be necessary to install shuttering on the face of the east wall of the Lock between the 100m and 130m marks (as measured from the heel post of the inner east lock gate).

The shuttering will be in place from 0800 on 23 April 2019 to 1700 on 26 April 2019, inclusive.

Whilst the shuttering is in place, vessels with a beam exceeding 32.6m will not be accepted in the Lock and all vessels will be prohibited from coming alongside the east side of Gladstone Lock between the 100m and 130m marks.

Vessels that are too large to come alongside the east side of the Lock, either to the north or to the south of the prohibited area, must make use of the west side of the Lock. The Gladstone Dock Master should be consulted in the first instance regarding the side-to required in the Lock.

Whilst the shuttering is in place, fenders approximately 30cm deep will be positioned on either side of the shuttering.
