TEMPORARY REMOVAL OF AIDS TO NAVIGATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to facilitate the current dredging campaign in the Queens and Crosby Channels (and associated spoil dumping operations), the following aids to navigation will be removed from station over the next seven days:

Spoil (53° 34' 16"N 003° 17' 23"W)

Formby Safe Water Mark

Crosby Safe Water Mark

The General Situation and Movement Statement will be updated to provide details as to when each aid to navigation has been removed from station.

Whilst Formby SWM and Crosby SWM are off station, the following reference points should be taken in lieu in respect of the application of General Direction Nº15:

Formby SWM: A line drawn between Q4 and Q5

Crosby SWM: A line drawn between C12 and C15

Furthermore, whilst Crosby SWM is off station, the position of this reporting point for the application of General Direction Nº16(ii) should be taken as:

C15 Buoy (inward) or C12 Buoy (outward)

A further Notice will be issued when these aids to navigation are to be reinstated.
