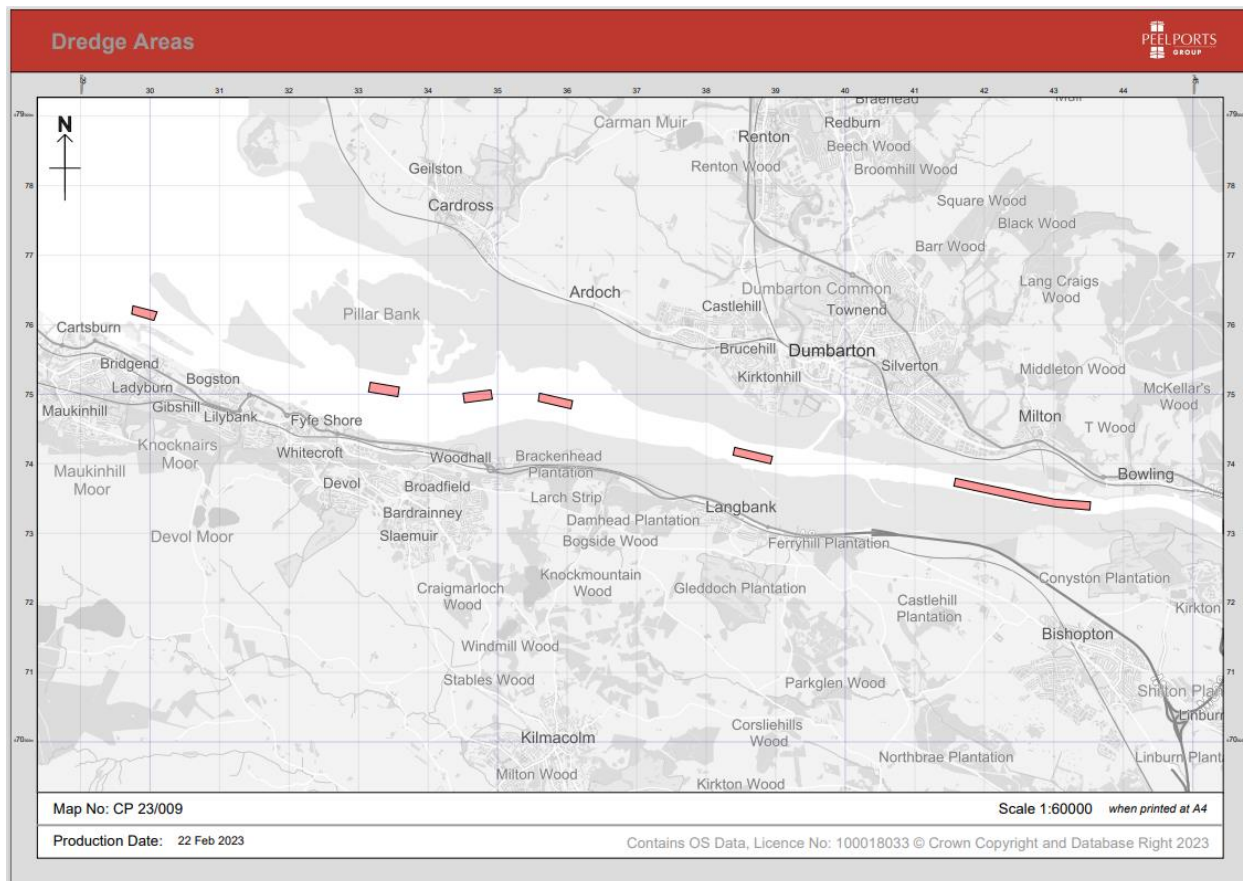


NOTICE TO MARINERS No 26/23 RIVER CLYDE – BAE GOVAN – FAIRFIELD’S BASIN DREDGING AND BASIN INFILLING WORKS

Mariners are advised that work is under way at BAE Govan to infill Fairfield’s Basin in preparation for the construction of a new Ship Assembly Hall.

Dredging is planned to provide infill material for the Basin from 2nd March for a period of approximately 4 weeks. This will be completed by the vessel MV SHOALWAY at various locations in the River Clyde as indicated below.





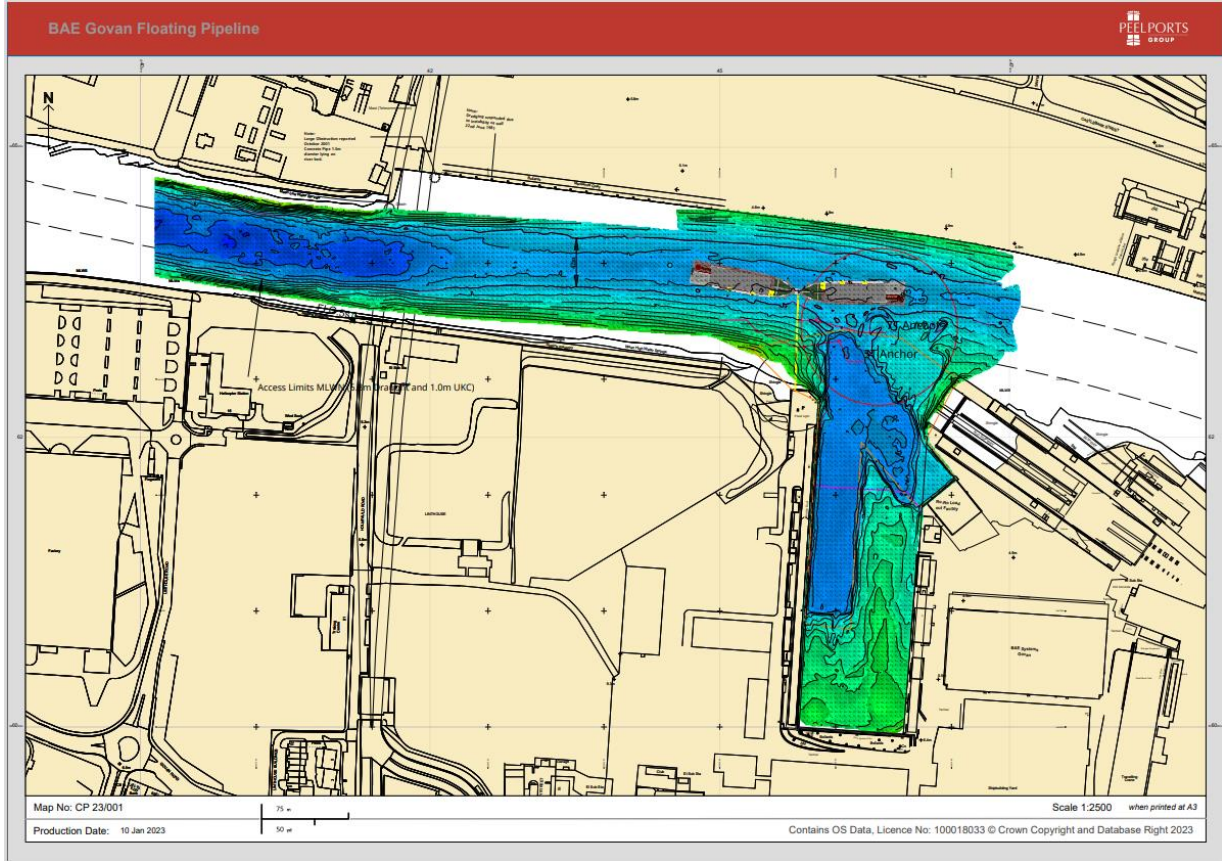
The MV Shoalway will be supported by workboat MEGAN M and survey vessel ARAMIS.



A temporary floating pipeline will be installed to facilitate pumping the dredged material into the Basin. This will be towed to site by the vessel MV FORTH JOUSTER in two sections during the period 22nd – 25th February 2023.



The floating pipeline will be anchored to the seabed and these locations will be marked by yellow pennant buoys. Lights will be installed on the pipeline and each anchor buoy.



Mariners are requested to navigate with caution and maintain a safe distance from the vessels involved.
