

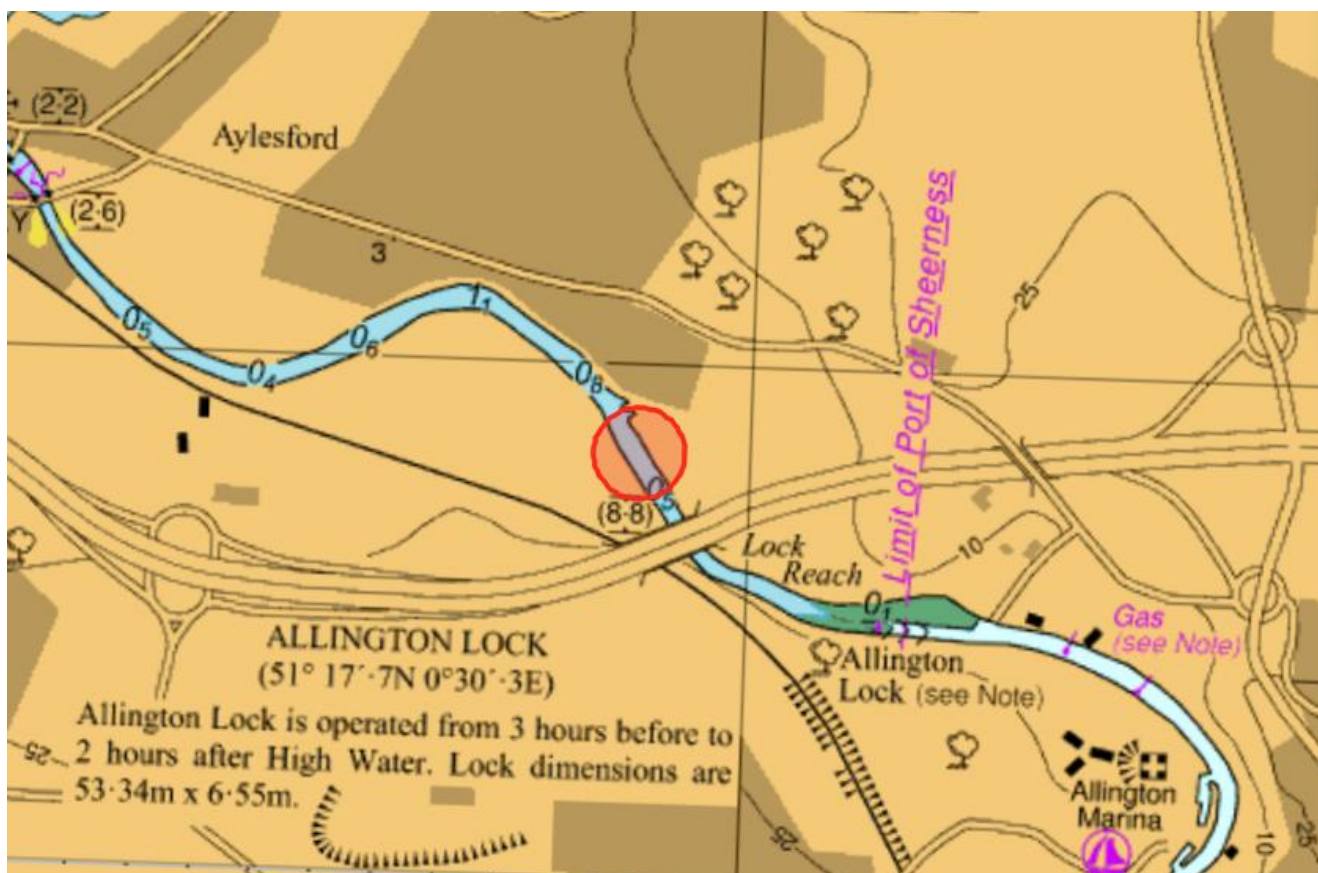
# NOTICE TO MARINERS

**NtoM 23 - 2026**

## River Medway – Allington (M20 Bridge)

### Sunken Vessel – Cancelled

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a motor cruiser grounded and subsequently sunk downstream of the M20 Bridge, approximately 620m downstream from Allington Lock. The boat is currently believed to not be visible at highwater. Peel Ports and the Environment Agency will continue to monitor the craft **which may move further towards the centre of the river creating a hazard to other vessels. Mariners are advised to navigate with extreme caution** when passing the location and report any significant changes to [medway.marine@peelports.com](mailto:medway.marine@peelports.com) & contact Medway VTS. Efforts will be made to refloat and remove the vessel in the near future, a cancellation to this notice will be promulgated when the obstruction is cleared.
