Cloud thickening in the east and south, however, bringing some patchy rain to the southeast coast later. Highest temperatures of 9 to 12 degrees in moderate north to northwesterly breezes.</p> <p>TONIGHT: Quite a cloudy night then with outbreaks of rain spreading up along Leinster and east Ulster through the night, turning heavy and persistent in parts, with spot flooding possible. Some wintry falls may occur over the Wicklow mountains. Breezy near the east coast too. Mainly dry elsewhere with light northwesterly winds.
