


Mariners are advised that works are under way to redevelop the Ferry Terminal on Great Cumbrae. This project includes construction of a new slipway and land reclamation for new terminal infrastructure which will be supported by a new rock armour revetment. Dredging is also planned for the new slipway. The existing slipway will be demolished towards the end of the project.

A piling platform will be created using aggregate materials. The barge Aria S, supported by Coastbuster and Coastworker tugs will transfer aggregate from Hunterston Terminal to Cumbrae Ferry Terminal. The barge will position on spud legs at Cumbrae for discharge and a boom will be deployed. A safety boat will support operational periods. All vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch12.

Temporary navigation buoys with yellow lights flashing isophase will be laid in the following positions as indicated on the drawing below:

Mariners are requested to navigate with additional caution when navigating in this area and maintain a safe distance from the works and vessels involved in the project.
