

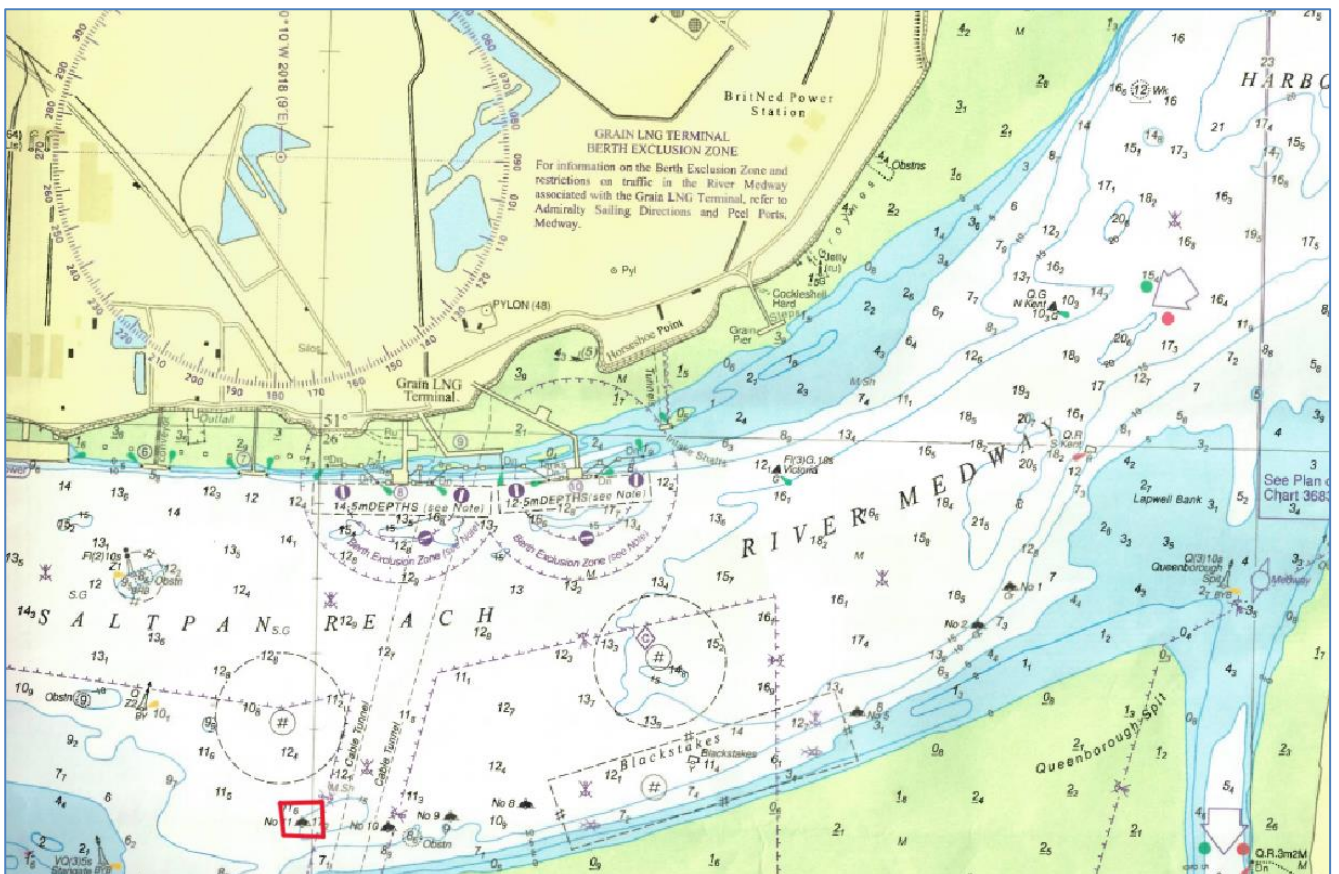
# NOTICE TO MARINERS

## No. 10 – 2024 (Updated 01.08.24)

### River Medway – Saltpan Reach Saltpan No.11 Mooring Buoy - Out of Commission.

**Update - NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Saltpan No.11 mooring buoy which was semi-submerged, has now been lifted and recovered to Sheerness. An orange pellet buoy has been temporarily placed in it's position until a permanent solution or replacement is found.**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Saltpan No.11 mooring buoy which is now semi-submerged, has been deemed unsafe to use and thus taken out of commission. The buoy is still afloat but less conspicuous to river users due to it's position in the water. The buoy remains in it's charted position but is now unoccupied, all river users are reminded to exercise caution when navigating in this area until the buoy is removed/recovered.
