

NOTICE TO MARINERS No 43/24 RIVER CLYDE – RENFREW INSTALLATION OF BRIDGE SPAN


Chart 2007 Plan B

Mariners are advised that the south span of the new Renfrew to Yoker Roadbridge will be delivered by barge and is due to transit from Cumbrae Pilot Station to site on 24th April 2024 supported by 2 harbour tugs and sea-going tug ATLANTIS. Barge CAROLINE will moor at the bridge site and begin preparations to offload the bridge span which is scheduled for the afternoon of Friday 26th April.

During the preparation phase, access for commercial vessels to pass the site will be severely restricted. Leisure vessels are advised to keep well clear on the north side of the channel.

During discharge and installation of the bridge span (afternoon of Friday 26th April), NO VESSEL IS PERMITTED TO PASS the bridge site.

On completion of the installation, the barge crew will begin preparations to depart on the afternoon of Sunday 28th April. Restrictions on vessels passing the site will be as detailed above for the preparation phase.
