CANCELLATION OF ALL CLYDEPORT NOTICES TO MARINERS

AND PORT INFORMATION NOTICES

ISSUED DURING 2020

Mariners are advised that all Clydeport Notices to Mariners and Port Information Notices issued prior to this date are cancelled, or considered sufficiently promulgated.

All new Notices issued take effect from 1st January 2021 and will be numbered consecutively for ease of reference.

Clydeport's area of jurisdiction is from the Albert Bridge in the City of Glasgow to the seaward limits of the Port, being:

- (a) to the east of the Isle of Arran a line drawn due east and west across the Firth of Clyde from Corrygills Point on the Isle of Arran, and
- (b) in Kilbrannan Sound a line drawn due east/west across the Firth from the north-west coast of Arran to the coast of Kintyre.

Clydeport's jurisdiction is as set out in Clyde Port Authority Order Confirmation Act (1965) and as amended (1969).
