BRAMLEY-MOORE DOCK PERMANENT CLOSURE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on or shortly after 19 August 2021, three special mark buoys will be deployed in Sandon Half-tide Dock approximately 25 m from the entrance to the passageway leading to Bramley-Moore Dock. The special mark buoys will be positioned as follows:

№1 53° 25.575043' N 003° 0.330489' W

№2 53° 25.575086' N 003° 0.306110' W

№3 53° 25.575233' N 003° 0.282276' W

Each buoy is a yellow pillar approximately 0.9 m in height which, during the hours of darkness, will display a light with the characteristic Fl. Y. 4s.

Following deployment of these special mark buoys, a silt screen will be positioned across the north-end of the passageway leading to Bramley-Moore Dock and work will then commence on the permanent closure of this dock by the construction of a bund in the passageway.

Vessels navigating in Sandon Half-tide Dock must do so at reduced speed (to avoid excessive wash impinging on the silt screen and bund construction work) and must not pass beyond the line of the three special mark buoys.
