

Supplementary Information D: Places of Refuge in Clydeport Harbour Area

Places of Refuge (PoR) are location into which a ship is in need of assistance can be brought, so that its condition can be stabilised and consequential pollution damage to the seas and coasts be averted.

In the UK, the Marine Safety Act 2003 provides powers of interventions and direction to the SOSREP, working with the MCAs Counter Pollution Branch. SOSREP oversees all incident in UK waters where there is significant risk of pollution, and he or the MCA directs vessels to PoR where he judges it appropriate.

When a ship in need of assistance required a PoR, SOSREP will take account of all the factors which relate to the specific incident (e.g. weather) the location and type of threat posed by the vessel and its cargo, with a view to determining the most appropriate PoR minimising adverse consequences.
