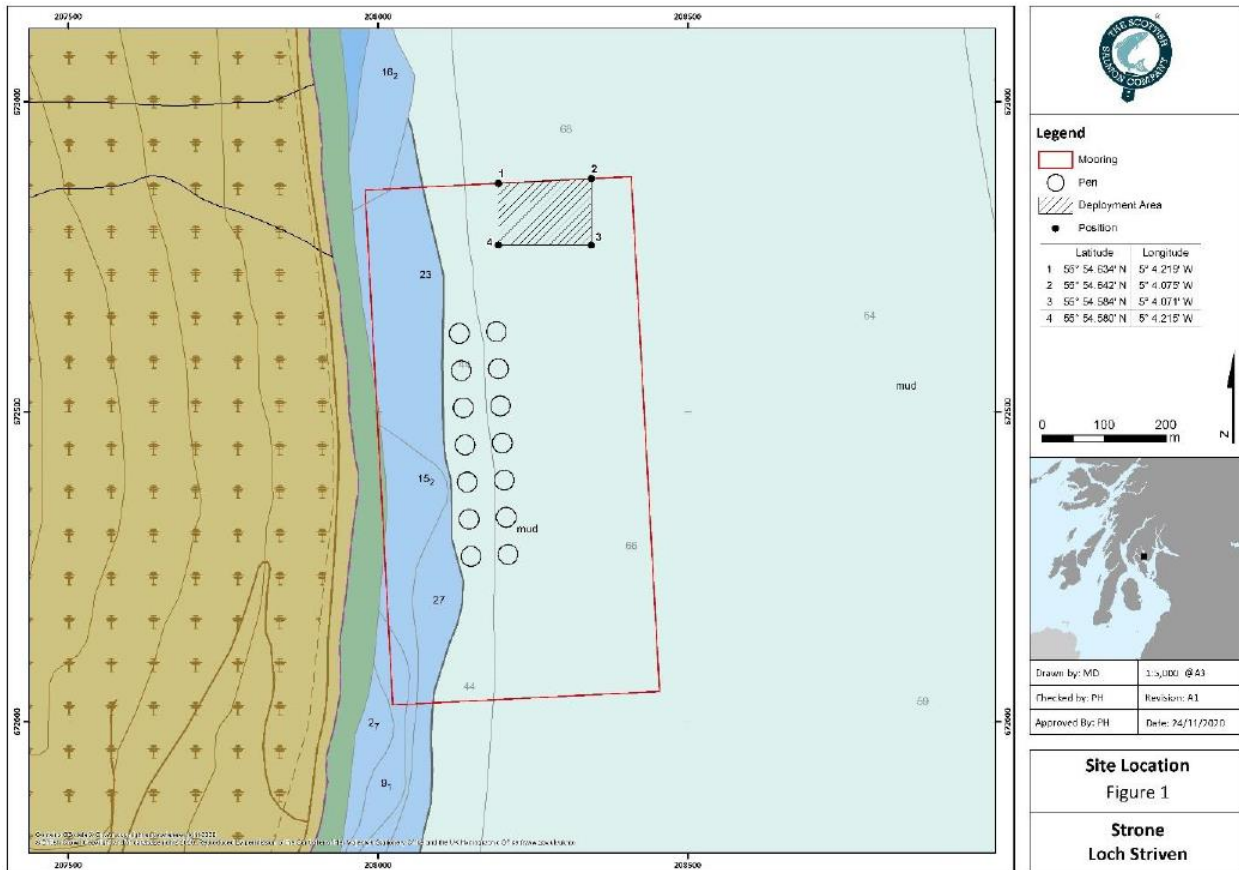
LOCH STRIVEN – STRONE

DEPLOYMENT OF TEMPORARY BUOY

Mariners are advised that a temporary Lit Special Mark Data Buoy will be deployed on 3rd March 2021 within the existing finfish site mooring area in Loch Striven, in the vicinity of Strone Point. The buoy is expected to remain in position for approximately 12 months.

The deployment location is marked by 1 yellow buoy, with the topmark “X” and Fl (5) Y 20s flash sequence.



The buoy will be laid by the vessel “MV Lady of Striven” which will display all appropriate shapes and lights during operational periods. A listening watch will be maintained on VHF Ch 12.
