- (1) If the vessel is classified by Lloyd's Register of Shipping, or another society being a member of the International Association of Classification Societies, please provide a copy of the vessel's current Certificate of Class.
- (2) If the vessel is not classified as above, the Certificate of Seaworthiness and Safety (printed overleaf) must be completed by a surveyor of shipping for the time being approved by MSCC.
- (3) The Owner agrees to submit a revised application for Registration should the vessel's classification be amended, suspended or cancelled, or if any detail declared above is changed in any way whatsoever.
- (4) The Owner warrants and undertakes that during the period of this Registration, the vessel:
 - (a) will covered by P&I insurance with reputable P&I or London market insurers in respect of third party liability risks (including but not limited to cargo damage, pollution and wreck removal) and for levels of cover as would normally be taken out by a prudent operator of comparable vessels in similar trades (albeit, wreck recovery cover must be for at least £3m), and the Owner shall provide MSCC with documentary evidence of such insurance cover upon request; and
 - (b) will be operated by crew members who are suitably trained and qualified to undertake the vessel's intended purpose.
- (5) MSCC reserves the right to inspect the vessel at any time to ensure that the vessel remains seaworthy or suitable for the purpose for which the same was built, designed, fitted or intended or likely to be used.
