Highest temperatures of 6 to 10 degrees in mostly light to moderate south to southwest winds, fresher in western parts. TONIGHT: It'll be dry in many areas tonight with long clear spells, though there'll be some scattered showers in western coastal parts. Cloud will start to build from the west overnight. Lowest temperatures of 0 to 5 degrees, coldest further east, with some frost possible.
