Highest temperatures of 6 to 9 degrees in light to moderate and variable winds, freshening in Ulster this evening.</p> <p>TONIGHT: Wet for a time tonight across Ulster, north Leinster and the north Midlands with further spot flooding. Rain will clear northwards overnight with well scattered showers and clear spells following for the rest of the night. However, areas of mist and fog will develop. Moderate to fresh easterly winds in Ulster at first, but otherwise winds will be light and variable.
