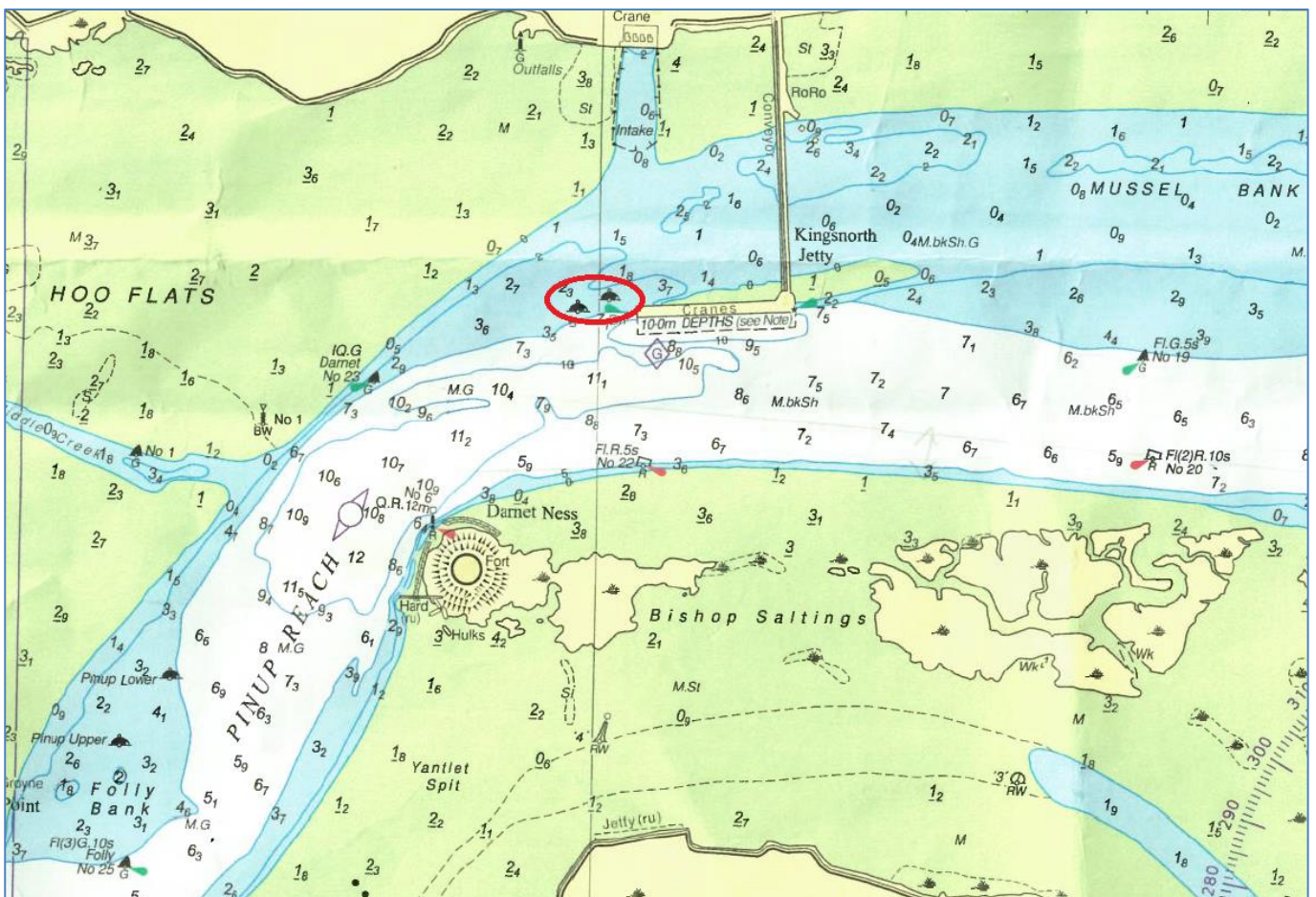

### River Medway – Long Reach – Kingsnorth Jetty Removal of Mooring Buoys

Notice is hereby given that: work to recover the buoys and groundwork will require diver assistance which will continue into next week. Completion of the work is now expected on or around 30.07.2021, passing vessels are reminded to navigate with caution and reduce their wash when “Liftmoor” is on site.

Notice is hereby given that: Peel Ports London Medway will be permanently removing the two mooring buoys currently located to the west of Kingsnorth Jetty.



# NOTICE TO MARINERS



The multi-cat vessel “Liftmoor” will commence work on 19/07/2021 and will be on site for approximately 3 days. The intention is to retrieve both mooring buoys and completely recover all riser chains and associated groundwork which will then be transported to Sheerness. Whilst lifting/recovery operations are underway passing vessels are requested to navigate with caution and reduce their wash. - Admiralty Chart No. 1835 refers.
