

STANDING NOTICE TO MARINERS No 11 PORT WASTE RECEPTION FACILITIES

These Port Waste Reception Regulations place requirements on ships to notify Ports and Terminals within the Clydeport area of jurisdiction, in advance of their arrival, of the type and quantities of waste onboard. All vessels should deliver waste to the reception facilities provided before leaving the Port/Terminal and are required to pay a mandatory charge, whether or not they use the facilities, to contribute to the cost of providing waste reception areas.

Clydeport Operations Ltd require all vessels to deliver their Port Waste Notification Form by telephone or e-mail to the appropriate Operations Manager or independent Terminal Operator at least 24 hours in advance of arrival.
