

Port of Sheerness Ltd (Peel Ports London Medway) is the Competent and Statutory Harbour Authority for the tidal Medway and the Swale and is party to a joint arrangement with the Port of London Authority in respect of part of the Thames Estuary pursuant to the Pilotage Act 1987.

The Peel Ports London Medway Marine Safety Management System and Pilotage Directions require that, following an incident, Pilots, PEC holders or Mariners complete a Marine Incident Report Form at the earliest available opportunity and in any event within 24 hours of arrival at the next port. For the purposes of this form an incident includes any marine accident, incident or near miss. The Medway Ports River Byelaws also require that the master of a vessel gives notice of an incident as soon as reasonably practicable after the event.
