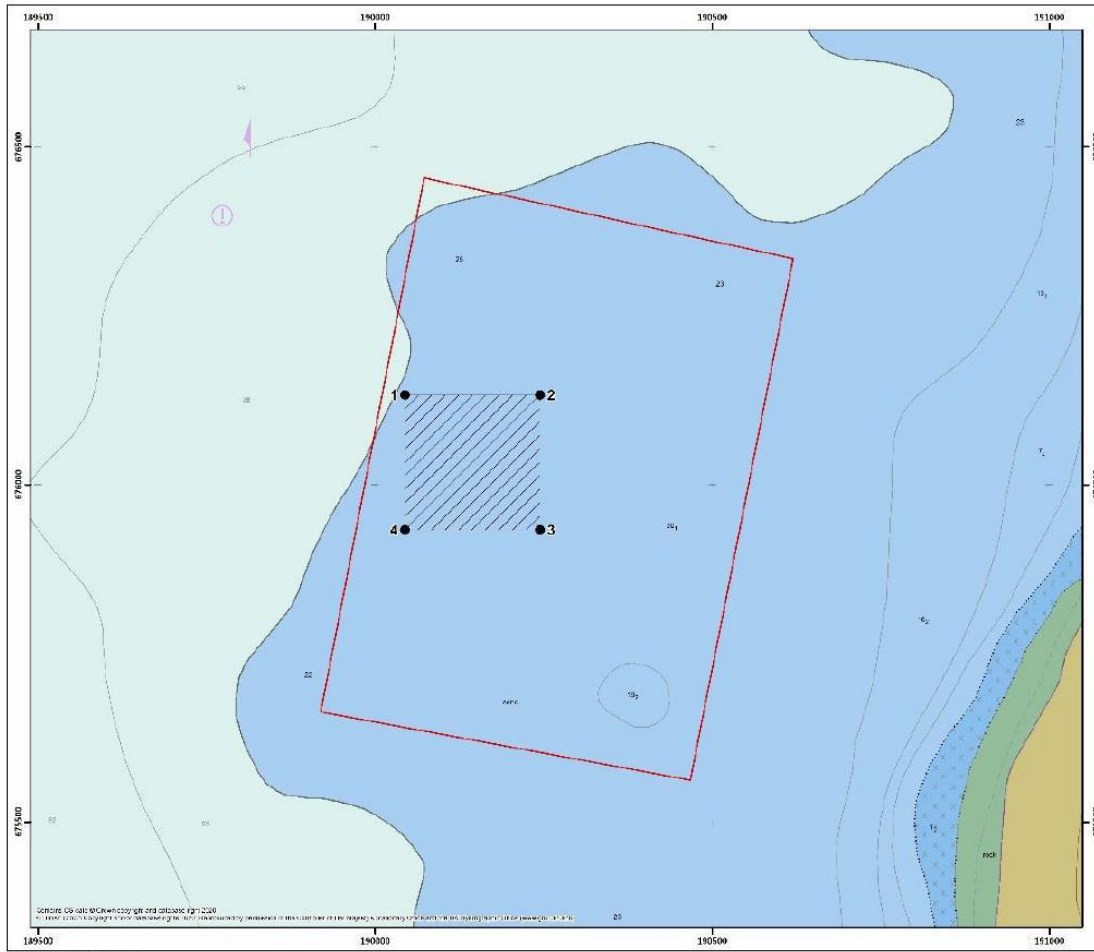

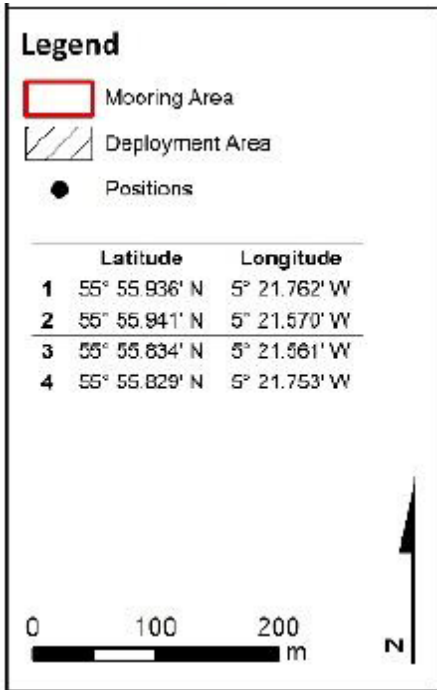
Mariners are advised that hydrographic survey equipment will be deployed on or around Friday 9<sup>th</sup> April in a position to the north of Auchalick Bay on the east side of Lower Loch Fyne as indicated on the following chart extract. The equipment is expected to remain in position until approximately mid-June 2021.

The deployment location will be marked by 1 yellow buoy, marked “SURVEY” and one orange buoy.
