

River Medway – Allington (M20 Bridge)

Sunken Vessel

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a motor cruiser grounded and subsequently sunk adjacent to the M20 Bridge approximately 500m downstream from Allington Lock. The boat is currently lying at an acute angle on the South West slope of the river bed and may only be partially visible at high water. Peel Ports and the Environment Agency will continue to monitor the craft which may move further towards the centre of the river creating a hazard to other vessels. Mariners are advised to navigate with extreme caution when passing the location and report any significant changes to medway.marine@peelports.com or contact Medway VTS. Efforts will be made to refloat and remove the vessel in the near future, a cancellation to this notice will be promulgated when the obstruction is cleared.
