

Notice to Mariners N°18A 2026

Diving Operations at Great Yarmouth Power Station River Intake Update

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that survey and maintenance works will be conducted on the power station river intakes between berths 5C and 6 (Port Marks 91 – 96) within the Great Yarmouth River Port for approximately four weeks **between Monday 27th April and Sunday 24th May 2026**. The works will include diving operations undertaken by Red7 Inshore Diving Ltd **between the hours of 0500 hours and 2000 hours daily**.

Divers will be working from the quay face and within the power station intakes using underwater tools and equipment. The International Code flag 'A' will be exhibited when dive operations are taking place and red flags will be exhibited marking the extremities of the works.

All vessel masters must obtain information from Yarmouth Radio on VHF Channel 12 before passing or approaching the dive location.

Any vessel intending to approach or depart berths; or conduct any movement or operation of engines or thrusters close to, or adjacent to the work area when operations are taking place must advise LPS in good time, and confirm that divers are clear of the water before doing so.

Masters are advised to exercise caution when passing the dive site, to keep well clear of the works area and to pass at the slowest safe manoeuvring speed. Swinging of vessels will not be permitted anywhere within the vicinity of the works area while diving is taking place.
