

Notice to Mariners N° 22 2026

Outer Harbour Dredging and Survey Operations

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that maintenance dredging and associated survey operations will be undertaken in the Outer Harbour and the immediate seaward approaches commencing on or around **Friday 15th May 2026**, with completion expected **Friday 29th May 2026**. Dredger MAAS will be working 24h and the schedule of operations will be determined by berth occupancy and weather conditions.

Associated hydrographic survey will be undertaken by vessel RS11, which will be working in the Outer Harbour and seaward approaches intermittently during daylight hours.

Issued on behalf of Great Yarmouth Port Authority, the Statutory Harbour Authority for the Port of Great Yarmouth
Telephone calls, VHF radio traffic, CCTV and radar traffic images may be recorded at
the Peel Ports Group Port Control Centre, Liverpool.

Both vessels will display appropriate day shapes and lights in accordance with the COLREGs.

Great Yarmouth LPS will provide contemporaneous information regarding dredging and survey activity on request.

Vessels may be restricted in their ability to manoeuvre and mariners are requested to be vigilant, maintain safe distance, minimise wash and keep clear of working tracks where safe to do so.

Mariners are reminded to maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 whilst navigating within the Port of Great Yarmouth and to advise 'Yarmouth Radio' of their intention to conduct any manoeuvre within the Port prior to doing so.
