CANADA 90' SWING BRIDGE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Canada 90' Swing Bridge will be partially opened and will remain in that position during the following period:

27 July 2026

18.30 until 20.30

During this period, the following must be considered:

1. The bridge's south end will project 1.0m from its recess on the west side of the passageway. Only highly manoeuvrable vessels of beam not exceeding 15m and that are capable of giving the bridge a wide berth while complying with point (2) should attempt to navigate through the passageway.
2. Vessels must pass the bridge at a minimum safe speed through the water to avoid putting wash into the bridge recess where personnel may be working.
3. A workboat will be operating in the area of the bridge, transporting pedestrians between the east and west sides of the docks.
4. Before passing through the bridge passageway, vessels must obtain permission from the Langton Dockmaster on VHF Ch. 21.
5. Vessels inward or outward bound via Langton Lock and requiring mooring services must confirm with their mooring service providers on which side of Langton Lock the linesmen will attend.

Unless notice is given to the contrary, this Notice will be withdrawn at 20.30 on 27 July 2026.
