HEYSHAM HARBOUR

DEPLOYMENT OF SEABED INSTRUMENTS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, on 14 September 2022, two seabed instruments will be deployed outside the buoy-line on the southern side of the Heysham Harbour approach channel.

The deployment will be carried out by the workboat *Torch* (call sign: MQJA8).

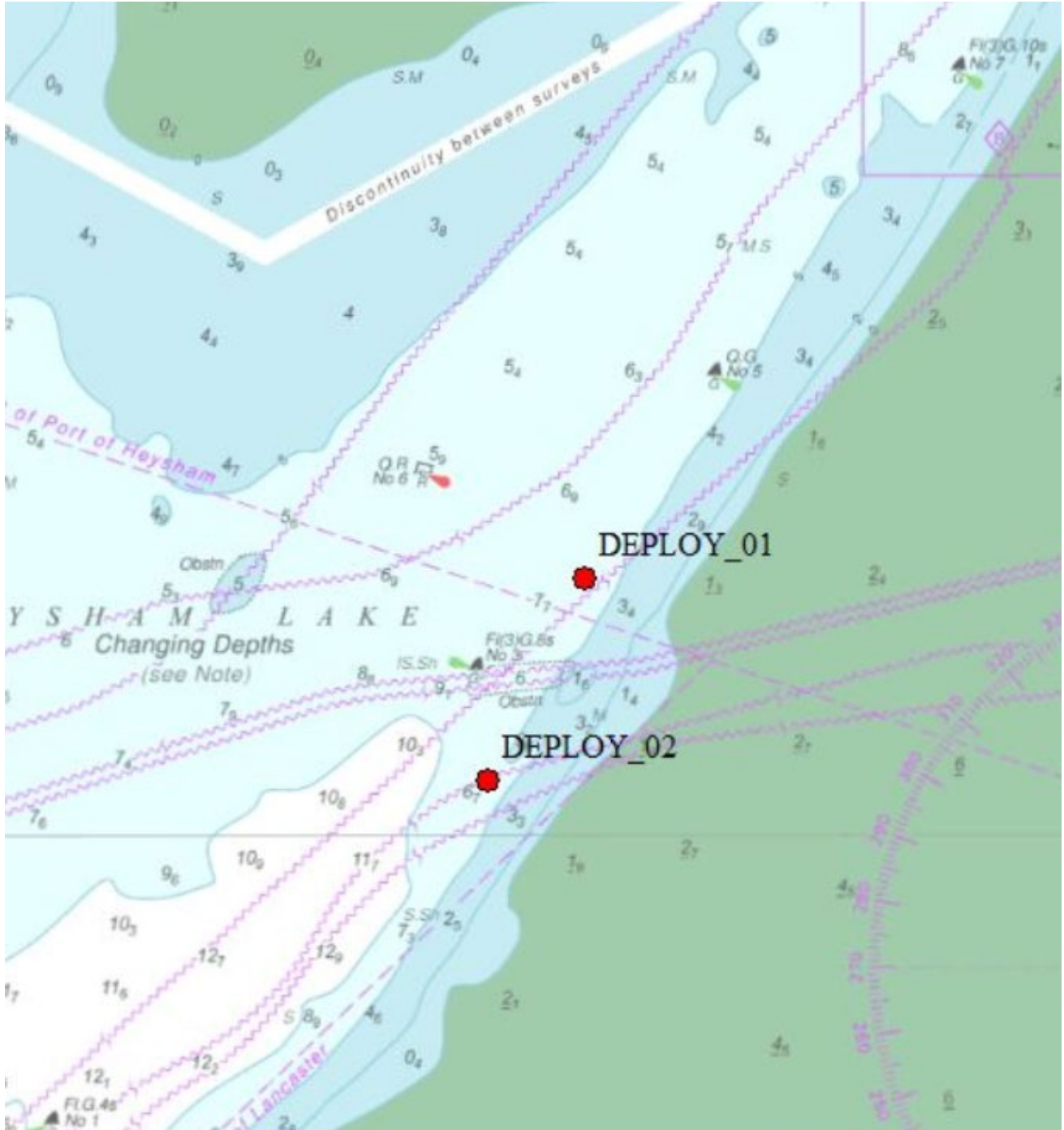
Each instrument will be marked by a 1.2m diameter, yellow special mark buoy fitted with a yellow Saint Andrew's Cross top mark and light with the characteristic Fl. (5) Y. 20s.

The instruments and associated buoys will be deployed in the following positions on either side of №3 starboard lateral mark:

ID	Position
DEPLOY_01	54° 00' 26.78015" N 002° 57' 42.12548" W
DEPLOY_02	54° 00' 05.75353" N 002° 57' 59.17073" W

These positions, relative to the approach channel, are shown on the accompanying diagram.

It is expected that the instruments and buoys will remain on station until 19 October 2022. However, a further Notice will be issued when the instruments and buoys have been removed.
