



NOTICE TO MARINERS No 24/22 V2 RUSSIAN AND BELARUSIAN VESSELS ENTERING UK PORTS

This NTM provides an update to CNTM No 24/22 in line with the latest amendment to UK sanctions regarding Russia and the Republic of Belarus. The UK Government has published guidance at <https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/russia-sanctions-guidance>

Due to the current situation in Ukraine the UK Government does not consider it appropriate for Russian and Belarusian vessels to enter UK Ports. Russian and Belarusian vessels, as defined below, will be declined permission to enter the Port of Clydeport (Statutory Harbour Authority) until further notice.

Vessels:

- Owned, controlled, chartered, or operated by a designated person,
- Owned, controlled, chartered or operated by persons connected with Russia or Belarus,
- Flying the flag of Russia or Belarus,
- Registered in Russia or Belarus,
- A specified ship.

Guidance on what is meant by “connected with Russia/Belarus” and “specified ship” is provided in the UK Government Regulations detailed above.

Affected vessels should contact their Agent or Owners for further orders.
