

Notice to Mariners N°23 2026

Diving Operations at Berth 08B

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Diving Operations will be conducted on MV Esvagt Njord at **berth 08B** on **20/05/2026** between the hours of **13:00 and 21:00**. The operation will be undertaken by Red7 Inshore Diving Ltd. The Dive Supervisor will monitor VHF Ch12 for the duration of the diving operations (station name RED7 DIVERS).

Divers will be working from the quay face and within the vicinity of MV Esvagt Njord which is berthed at 08B. The International Code flag 'A' will be exhibited when dive operations are taking place and red flags will be exhibited marking the extremities of the works.

All vessel masters must obtain information from Yarmouth Radio on VHF Channel 12 before passing or approaching the dive location.

Any vessel intending to approach or depart berths; or conduct any movement or operation of engines or thrusters close to, or adjacent to the work area when operations are taking place must advise LPS in good time, and confirm that divers are clear of the water before doing so.

Masters are advised to exercise caution when passing the dive site, to keep well clear of the works area and to pass at the slowest safe manoeuvring speed. Swinging of vessels will not be permitted anywhere within the vicinity of the works area while diving is taking place.
