Peel Ports London Medway Boatmasters Licence - Local Knowledge Endorsement

Notice is hereby given that: under the Merchant Shipping (Boatmasters' Qualifications, Crew and Hours of Work Regulations 2015), all Masters operating using a Boatmasters licence on the Medway, specifically the waters within a line from Garrison Point to Grain Tower thence west to shore-line and from the east limits of the Port of Sheerness to Rochester Bridge including the Swale as far as Shellness must have a Local Knowledge endorsement (LKE).

The Port of Sheerness Ltd have reviewed the process and below is the new process:

- Download the LKE pack from Peel Ports Website (under Navigation & Pilot Information section): https://www.peelports.com/marine/our-ports/london-medway
- 2. Ensure all requirements are met:
 - a. **First applications:**80 qualifying days (Min. 8 hrs) service with the last day being no more than 5 years after first date.
 - b. **Revalidations:** 60 qualifying days (Min. 8 hrs) within preceding 5 years of application.
- 3. Complete application form and submit with supporting evidence as described on the form to <u>Medway.MarineLicensing@peelports.com</u>
- 4. A member of the marine team will contact you within 14 working days to organise a time to attend Sheerness for a oral exam.
- 5. After successful examination a certificate will be issued, for submission to MCA.
