CONSULTATION ON THE PROPOSED DISCONTINUATION OF NAVIGATION MARKS

Notice is hereby given that: Peel Ports London Medway is planning to discontinue the following navigation marks:

- The Cant - 'D' Beacon (unlit) approximately 1nm South of MAC buoys 5/6
- Sheerness Harbour - Grain Light (QW) just South of Grain outfall channel
- Sharfleet Creek (East & Western ends) - Beacons 7&8 (unlit) ex Admiralty beacons
- Loden Hope - West Point Beacon (unlit)
- Swale – Long Reach - Cods Creek Beacon
- Bee Ness Buoy (Fl G 5s).

The above-mentioned proposal will be subject to a consultation period that will run until 7th February 2022. Comments and queries should be sent to:
