Weather Status:	TODAY: It'll be warm and mainly sunny today. A few showers will bubble up at times, most likely across the midlands and west, and a few could be heavy with the chance of the odd isolated thunderstorm. However, the showers will be hit and miss, with many areas escaping. Highest temperatures of 19 to 24, possibly 25 degrees, with mainly light south to southeasterly breezes. TONIGHT: Any showers or thunderstorms will ease and die away early tonight and most places will be dry and clear. Thickening cloud in the northwest will start to extend southeastwards overnight, with patchy outbreaks of light rain or drizzle affecting parts of Connacht and Ulster. Areas of mist and fog will form too.
